SUBJECT: **Mid-month post adjustment classification memo for August 2018**

1. I am pleased to send you the post adjustment multipliers for August 2018. Note that only duty stations with changes in post adjustment multipliers as compared to the previous memo ICSC-PADJ-0818-01 are listed.

**Group I Duty Stations**

2. The post adjustment multipliers, applicable to group I duty stations, as a result of the operation of the 0.5 per cent rule under conditions of currency depreciation/appreciation relative to the US dollar, with effect from 1 August 2018, are given in Table 1.

3. The post adjustment multipliers based on the results of the most recent cost-of-living surveys with effect from 1 August 2018 are listed in Table 2.
