[†] The list above was updated to reflect the changes since its initial publishing effective 1 January 2019. Effective 1 July 2020, Bule Hora and Tongo, Ethiopia were designated as non-family duty station and Beira, Mozambique, was formally classified as an overall “D” category duty station and removed from this list effective 1 July 2020. Effective 1 January 2021 Meiganga, Cameroon became “E” and was added to the list. Nchelenge, Zambia was removed as it became an overall “D” category duty station. Bafata and Buba, Guinea Bissau, Kenema, Sierra Leone, and Mpanda, Tanzania were also removed as they were reported inactive.
