## I.

## INTRODUCTION

A consolidated schedule of post adjustment classifications and threshold figures used for calculating rental subsidies (or deductions) is attached.

Names of countries and areas, which appear in English alphabetical order, are indexed in French in the list attached to the schedule.

In cases where only one post adjustment classification is shown for a country, normally for the capital city, that classification will be applicable for all duty stations within the country.

This schedule is effective **1 January 2022**, unless otherwise indicated, and supersedes any schedule previously published. It is available on the ICSC home page <http://icsc.un.org>

## II. DESCRIPTION OF DATA APPEARING IN PAC CIRCULARS

1. **Country or area** - Name of country or area appears under this column.
2. **Exchange rate** - Latest exchange rate.
3. **Post adjustment**
  - Index* - The post adjustment index (PAI) used to determine the latest post adjustment multiplier.
  - Mult.* - Post adjustment multiplier.
  - Chg. ind.* - Change indicator. When revised post adjustment classification (PAC) is reported in the circular for the first time, a 'Y' will appear under this column.
  - Eff. date* - Effective date of PAC (multiplier).
  - Reason for change* - When the revised PAC is reported in the circular for the first time the reason for change is shown under this column.
4. **Thresholds**
  - With allowances* - Threshold percentage figure applicable for staff in receipt of the Spouse or Single parent allowance.
  - Without allowances* - Threshold percentage figure applicable for staff not in receipt of the Spouse or Single parent allowance.
  - Calc. ind.* - Calculation indicator. When a 'Y' appears in a column, all housing subsidies at the duty station must be recalculated effective the date shown in the next column.
  - Eff. date* - Effective date of threshold percentages shown in the circular.

#### **IV. Consolidation of post adjustment into base salary**

1. The General Assembly, by resolution A/RES/76/240, approved a revised base/floor salary scale for staff in the Professional and higher categories effective 1 January 2022. The revised scale has been implemented in conjunction with a consolidation of 0.92 per cent of post adjustment into net base salary on a no gain/no loss basis. This means that the net base salary is increased by 0.92 per cent and post adjustment indices and multipliers at all duty stations are reduced by the same rate, effective the same date. The methodology for implementing the consolidation is outlined in Annex I. Multipliers before and after consolidation of 0.92 per cent of post adjustment into net base salary are provided in Annex II.

#### **V. Special measures to mitigate the negative impact of the COVID-19 global pandemic on post adjustment classifications of group I duty stations**

2. Given that the ICSC has suspended its survey programme as a result of the disruptions in global markets, and the attendant lockdowns, both legally established and de facto, due to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, the ICSC Chair has decided, under his delegated authority, to approve the promulgation of a special measure for group I duty stations where staff incur a significant share of local expenditures in non-local currencies, with effect from 1 June 2020, until further notice. This measure entails a modification of the 0.5 percent rule, to guarantee stability of each of two separate portions of the net take-home pay (NTP), one set in local currency and the other in US dollars. The proportions of the two NTP components are based on the proportions of local expenditures incurred in local and non-local currencies, as measured with the most recent place-to-place survey at the duty station. See document ICSC/CIRC/GEN/06/2020 for details. Please note that five duty stations were found to be eligible for this special measure: Bulgaria, Croatia, Hungary, Poland and Romania. For January 2022 this special measure was applicable only for **Romania**. For Bulgaria, Croatia, Hungary and Poland the post adjustment multipliers derived from the special measure turned out to be lower than those based on the 0.5 percent rule.

#### **VI. Cost-of-living surveys**

3. The results of cost-of-living surveys for duty stations listed in Table 1 are included in the attached Consolidated Post Adjustment Circular.

## **VII. Amendment to implementation of cost-of-living survey results for Saudi Arabia**

4. The implementation in December 2021 of the latest cost-of-living survey for Saudi Arabia (conducted in July 2021), did not account for value added taxes (VAT) applicable to most of price data collected for that survey.

5. After application of VAT, based on survey results, a higher post adjustment index of 149.9 was re-implemented effective 1 December 2021. This new index **did not trigger** a change to the prevailing post adjustment multiplier of 51.8. As a result, the previously communicated effects of the gap closure measure, including the institution of a personal transitional allowance (PTA), are now **cancelled**. No retroactive payment to existing staff is needed for the month of December 2021, as the level of remuneration due based on re-implemented survey results is equivalent to the sum of multiplier and PTA under the prior implementation. This assessment reverses the survey results report for Saudi Arabia, which was communicated with ICSC-PADJ-1221-01 on 14 December 2021.

## **VIII. Duty Stations with Personal Transitional Allowance (PTA)**

6. Under the existing system of operational rules, the PTA is adjusted periodically until it is phased out. During an adjustment month, the new PTA is calculated by reducing the pay index for existing staff by 3 per cent, and then subtracting the prevailing pay index. Table 2 is a summary of all PTAs in effect as of 1 January 2022.

7. In line with the special measures, ICSC/CIRC/GEN/05/2020, to mitigate the negative impact of COVID-19 pandemic on post adjustment classifications of group II duty stations, the PTA revision cycle is frozen as of 1 April 2020 and there will be no further downward adjustment of the PTA for the duty stations in Table 2, until the special measures are discontinued. The existing PTA will be applied to all staff at the duty station (not just staff on post before the date of implementation of the survey results) as of 1 April 2020 and the revision cycle will resume its regular course upon the lifting of the special measures. Staff on post after the first implementation of the PTA, but before 1 April 2020, are not eligible for the PTA for the period of service before 1 April 2020, the date that the special measure came into force. Table 2 also provides the applicable start date of the PTA to all staff.

## **IX. One Month Rule**

8. Due to sustained substantial inflation over the past six- and twelve-month periods, the one-month rule is applicable for **Lebanon**, **Sudan** and **Suriname**. Under this rule, the post adjustment multipliers of these duty stations are reviewed on a monthly basis during the period of substantial inflation. Based on the application of the one-month rule, the applicable post adjustment multiplier for **Lebanon** effective 1 January 2022 is listed in the attached Consolidated Post Adjustment Circular. The application of the one-month rule did not trigger any change in the post adjustment multipliers for **Sudan** and **Suriname**.

## **X. W40 Measure**

9. The waiver of the 40 per cent of rent limit on rental subsidies **is no longer applicable** for **Cote d'Ivoire**, effective 1 January 2022.

## **ANNEX I**

### **ADJUSTMENT OF THE BASE/FLOOR SALARY SCALE FOR STAFF IN THE PROFESSIONAL AND HIGHER CATEGORIES (EFFECTIVE 1 JANUARY 2022)**

1. Pursuant to General Assembly resolution A/RES/76/240, the base/floor salary scale effective 1 January 2022 for staff in the Professional and higher categories is increased by 0.92 per cent at all grades and steps. This revised base/floor scale reflects a consolidation of 0.92 per cent of post adjustment into net base salary and is implemented effective 1 January 2022.
2. In accordance with the established practice, the consolidation of 0.92 per cent has been implemented on a “no loss, no gain” basis. Consequently, the base/floor has been increased by 0.92 per cent and the post adjustment indices and multipliers applicable at all duty stations have been reduced by the same percentage, so that the net remuneration remains unchanged.
3. The base/floor salary scale is also used to calculate some separation payments. As of 1 January 2022, these payments will be subject to an increase, as a result of the increase in the base/floor salary scale.
4. For all duty stations, the post adjustment multipliers for January 2022 are determined using the normal procedures, and then multipliers reduced using the procedure outlined in the attached annex. This annex also gives some examples of the impact of the introduction of the revised base/floor salary scale on the level of the net remuneration.
5. It should be noted that the base/floor salary scale is also used to calculate some of the separation payments. Thus, staff leaving the service on or after 1 January 2022 and who are entitled to these payments will experience some gains as a result of the adjustment of the base/floor salary scale.
6. It should also be noted that the adjustment of the base/floor salary scale is not linked to that of the pensionable remuneration scale for the Professional and higher categories of staff.
