

## **Wang Xiaochu (China)**

In February 2013, Mr Wang was elected as deputy of the 12<sup>th</sup> National People's Congress (NPC) of the People's Republic of China. Following this in March 2013 he was elected as Vice Chairman of the Foreign Affairs Committee of the 12<sup>th</sup> NPC at its first session.

Mr. Wang continues to serve as the Vice Minister of the Ministry of Human Resources and Social Security of the People's Republic of China, in charge of human resources development and management. He has been a member of the International Civil Service Commission (ICSC) of the United Nations since 2005. Mr. Wang was Vice Minister of Personnel of the People's Republic of China from 2003 to 2008. From 1996 to 2003, he served successively as Deputy Director-General and Director-General of the Department of International Exchange and Cooperation of the Ministry of personnel. From 1993 to 1996, he worked as a Counsellor at the Permanent Mission of China to United Nations in New York. He was a member of the Chinese delegation from the 47<sup>th</sup> through 50<sup>th</sup> sessions of the General Assembly of the United Nations, and representative of China to the Fifth Committee .

Mr. Wang has been the head of the Chinese government delegation to the International Labor Conferences since 2009. He was Vice President of the Organizing Committee of the 5<sup>th</sup> Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) Ministerial Meeting on Human Resources Development (Beijing, 2010) and the Executive Director of the Organizing Committee of the APEC High-Level Meeting on Human Capacity Building (Beijing, 2001). From 1998 to 2000, he was the Lead Shepherd of the Human Resources Development Working Group of APEC, organized and chaired the 19<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> Working Group meetings, and co-chaired the Planning Committees of the 3<sup>rd</sup> (Washington, D.C., United States, 1998) and 4<sup>th</sup> (Kumamoto, Japan 2000) APEC Ministerial Meetings on Human Resources Development. He was the Executive Director of the Organizing Committee of the 3<sup>rd</sup> International Conference of Administrative Sciences co-sponsored by the Chinese Government and the International Institute of Administrative Sciences in Beijing, 1996. Mr. Wang is a board member of the Chinese Society of Public Administration, and was a member of the Committee of Experts on Public Administration of the United Nations from 2004 to 2009.
