## Housing Surveys at Headquarters duty stations, 2008

In accordance with a decision of the International Civil Service Commission (ICSC) at its 66th session, the Cost-of-Living Division of the ICSC will be conducting a housing survey during the months of June 2008 in New York and September 2008 at all other Headquarters duty stations (Geneva, London, Madrid, Montreal, Paris, Rome, Vienna) and Washington, D.C. The questionnaire is a one-page, self-explanatory online form, available in three languages (English, French and Spanish). It is password-protected and can be accessed via the Internet, completed and submitted electronically in about 5 minutes.
